Ideas for yor tour



Visit to the “Tenura Hombre” + Museo Maserati

Visit to the Panini family’s Tenuta Hombre, a couple of miles from the racing circuit, a biological farm where Guests can admire vast land expanses, a 500-head herd of Italian Frisian cattle grazing freely and the manufacture of Parmigiano Reggiano cheese as it has been for centuries.

The Guests may buy any biological produce of the Farm.

Within the Farm the Guests will be able to visit the Umberto Panini Old Motor-Car and Motorcycle Museum, in which some 40 cars, 30 motorcycles, a few bicycles, various engines and interesting military vehicles are on display. The collection consists mostly of Maseratis.

Inside the Museum there is a railroad station mock-up as well.

A guide will illustrate the features of the land, the Parmigiano production, the Museum and the history of cars.



The Ferrari Gallery

Visit to the world-famous car gallery, the Ferrari Gallery.

The Ferrari Gallery, inaugurated in 1990, is where past, present and future melt together, embueing the visitor with the full appeal of the myth.

F1 racing cars, historical models, themed shows, technological break-throughs and photographic displays can be seen at the Gallery, which is organised into four areas.

A guide speaking the language requested will optionally be at the Guest’s disposal.



Tour of the Lamborghini Museum

The Lamborghini Museum is inside the Lamborghini factories and has a rotating exhibition of automobiles that demonstrate the various seasons experienced by the company from the 1960s to present: from the 350 GT series of 1963, to the Diablo, the Miura of 1966, the Countach of 1973 to the cars for Formula Uno, and many others.

The Company's history is also illustrated by numerous photographs, panels and small models from all over the world.



Tour of the Stanguellini Historical Car Museum

This museum is housed at the dealership of the same name and displays significant models and the Modenese automobiles which garnered hundreds of victories: Mille Miglia, Coppa Vanderbilt, European championships.

In addition to a theme-related collection of vehicles and "unique pieces" produced and altered from the early 1900s, there are numerous tools used for manufacturing and designing the cars.

You can admire the first sport cars 750 and 1100 of Fiat derivation, the engine entirely built by Stanguellini of 1950 and then the glorious Stanguellini Junior 1100 of the 1960s, winner of the G.P. of Montecarlo Junior from 1959, until reaching the celebrated Colibrì designed by Scaglione and the prestigious Formula 3.



Visit to the Righini Vintage Car Private Collection

Hosted in the Castle of Panzano in the Province of Modena in the space once used for utility rooms, the Righini collection is one of the most important vintage car collections of Italy.

Among the specimens on display, the Fiat Chiribiri 1912 served to beat the record in the launched kilometer race and the Auto Avio Costruzioni 815 of 1940, the first Ferrari ever made, but bearing another name: part of the mechanics came from the Fiat 508 C with a 1500cc/eight cylinder engine, but all the rest was built by Scuderia Ferrari which, due to a legal connection with the Alfa Romeo, could not yet use its own name for its race cars.
